

For native German speakers, finding the right translation, from German to English or vice versa, can sometimes be a challenge. Here are some examples to help you figure out how to say certain words. And to make sure you keep yourself out of trouble.

Its or it's?

It's very easy to confuse it's with its. Its, without an apostrophe, is the possessive version of a pronoun. 'The spider spun its web.'

It's, with an apostrophe, is a contraction of 'it is' or 'it has'. 'It is a very beautiful web' can be contracted to 'It's a very beautiful web'.

So, if you're bit unsure which to use, try adding 'it is' or 'it has' to the sentence and see if it still makes sense. If not, you need to use *its*.

Look, see or watch?

Look, see and watch all have different meanings and are used in different situations.

Look means to direct your eyes in a particular direction.

See means to become aware of someone or something by using your eyes.

Watch means to look at someone or something for an amount of time and pay attention to what is happening.
