  2. vermin - small animals and insects that can be harmful (Ungeziefer)
  3. shrub - a large plant with a rounded shape (Busch)
  4. dumpster - a large container for waste (Müllcontainer)
  5. obnoxious - very unpleasant or rude (unausstehlich)
  6. banister - a row of posts at the side of stairs supporting a bar on top (Geländer)
  7. leverage - the power to influence results (Durchsetzungsvermögen)
  8. lawyer - someone whose job it is to give advice to people in legal affairs (Anwalt)
  9. suspect - a person believed to have committed a crime (Verdächtiger)
  10. imagination - the ability to form pictures in the mind (Vorstellungskraft)
  11. consternation - a feeling of worry, shock, or confusion (Bestürzung)
  12. to contradict - to say the opposite of what someone else has said (widersprechen)
  13. machinations - complicated and secret plans to get power or control (Machenschaften)
  14. to appreciate - to recognize how good someone or something is (schätzen)
  15. nausea - the feeling that you are going to vomit (Übelkeit)

16. accusation - a statement saying that someone has done something wrong (Anschuldigung)
  17. provocation - an action or statement intended to make someone angry (Provokation)
  18. to bicker - to argue about things that are not important (hadern)
  19. forensics - scientific methods of solving crimes (Gerichtsmedizin, Kriminaltechnik)
  20. to summon - to order someone to be present at a particular place (herbefeilen)
  21. oblivious - not conscious of something (nichtsahnend, vergesslich)
  22. ambulance - a vehicle to take sick or injured people to hospital (Krankenwagen)
  23. altercation - a loud argument or disagreement (Auseinandersetzung)
  24. vehemence - the forceful expression of strong feelings (Heftigkeit)
  25. retrospect - thinking now about something in the past (Rückblick)
  26. headache - a pain you feel inside your head (Kopfschmerzen)
  27. waist - the part of the body above the hips (Taille)
  28. conscientious - putting a lot of effort into your work (gewissenhaft)
  29. awning - a frame-supported cover fastened to a building to protect someone or something from the sun or rain (Markise, Vordach)
  30. revelation - the act of making something known that was secret (Offenbarung)
