

For native German speakers, finding the right translation, from German to English or vice versa, can sometimes be a challenge. Here are some examples to help you figure out how to say certain words. And to make sure you keep yourself out of trouble.

Actually or currently?

What is the difference between actually and currently? English learners often confuse the two. If you want to talk about something happening now or at the present time, then you can use currently. For example, 'She is currently playing in a local hockey league, but soon she will change teams.'

Actually means 'in fact' or 'really' and is often used to make corrections: 'Actually, Portuguese is spoken in Brazil, not Spanish.'

Eventually or possibly?

It can be difficult for English learners to distinguish between *eventually* and *possibly*. Firstly, *eventually* means 'finally', 'ultimately', or 'in the end'. Example: 'Eventually, when the noise died down, I got to sleep.'

Meanwhile, *possibly* means 'perhaps' or 'maybe'. For example, 'It may *possibly* rain today, so remember to pack a raincoat.'
