- Die Verlaufsform der Vergangenheit (*past continuous*) wird gebildet aus *was / were* + *-ing*-Form des Verbs *was / were* + Grundform des Verbs. (Zur Bildung der *-ing*-Form siehe Seite 195.)
- Das *past continuous* wird verwendet, um über Handlungen zu sprechen, die in der Vergangenheit zu einem bestimmten Zeitpunkt im Gange waren. Wann die Handlung angefangen oder geendet hat, ist nicht wichtig; betont wird vor allem, dass sie zu einem bestimmten Zeitpunkt abgeschlossen nicht abgeschlossen war.
- Manche Verben werden in der Regel nicht in der Verlaufsform verwendet, z. B. *be*, *have* (im Sinne von ‚besitzen‘), *want* und *like*.
