The Chase

The Chase is a British television quiz show broadcast on ITV. Contestants play against a professional quizzier, known as the "chaser", who attempts to prevent them from winning a cash prize. The chaser's job is to catch each contestant during their individual chase, eliminating that person from the game. In Germany the format has been adopted as the quiz show "Gefragt – Gejagt".

“The Chase” (Instructions)

Two teams compete (Chasers and Contestants).

To win, the contestants must answer 8 questions correctly without being caught by the chasers. There is a maximum of 16 questions.

If the answer is correct, the team goes up one level, if the answer is not correct, the team stays where it is.

The chasers have to answer the same questions as the contestants, but they start two questions behind.

To win, their objective is to arrive at the same level as the contestants.

Each question has to be answered by one team member alone using a (hidden) answer card and without consulting the other team members.

The contestants have a multiple choice of 4 answers, the chasers have 3.
