

## Pronouns

### Personal pronouns

I, you, he, she, it, we, you, they

Personal pronouns are used to replace a **noun** (Hauptwort, Substantiv), **person** or **name**.

They are used as the **subject** of a sentence.

The **car** is nice. - **It** is nice.

The **man** has a beard. - **He** has a beard.

**Sarah** likes ice cream. - **She** likes ice cream.

## Pronouns

### Possessive pronouns

my, your, his, her, its, our, your, their

Possessive pronouns show **ownership** – who something belongs to.

(I) This is **my** book.

(She) **Her** bag is red.

(We) **Our** house is big.

## Pronouns

### Object pronouns

me, you, him, her, it, us, you, them

Object pronouns replace a **person or thing that receives the action** in a sentence (i.e. the **object** of a sentence).

(I) Can you help **me**?

(She) I see **her** every day.

(We) They call **us** in the morning.

## Pronouns
