  5. detergent - a chemical substance for removing dirt from clothes or dishes
  6. ordeal - a very unpleasant and painful or difficult experience
  7. blip - a temporary change that does not have any special meaning
  8. to stride - to walk somewhere quickly with long steps
  9. obedient - doing, or willing to do, what you have been told by someone in authority
  10. insane - very annoyed, angry, upset or excited
  11. to cheat - to have a secret sexual relationship with so. who is not your usual partner
  12. dresser - a piece of bedroom furniture with drawers
  13. to fess up - to admit that you have done sth. that so. else will not like
  14. to yank - to pull something forcefully with a quick movement
  15. to crouch - to bend your knees and lower yourself so that you are close to the ground

  17. to falter - to lose strength or purpose and stop, or almost stop (zaudern, stocken)
  18. to frame - to make a person seem to be guilty of a crime when they are not (verleumden)
  19. conspiracy - the activity of secretly planning with others to do sth. bad or illegal
  20. gibberish - spoken or written words that have no meaning
  21. to quake - to shake because you are frightened
  22. puddle - a small pool of liquid on the ground, esp. from rain
  23. spittle - liquid produced in the mouth
  24. phlegm - a thick substance in your mouth and throat that is produced when you have a cold
  25. curb/kerb - a raised edge along the side of a street
  26. lunatic - so. who behaves in a silly or dangerous way
  27. commotion - a sudden, short period of noise, confusion or excited movement (Tumult, Aufruhr)
  28. to scavenge - to look for or get food or other objects in other people's rubbish (plündern)
  29. scent - a pleasant natural smell
  30. to reassure - to comfort so. and stop them from worrying
