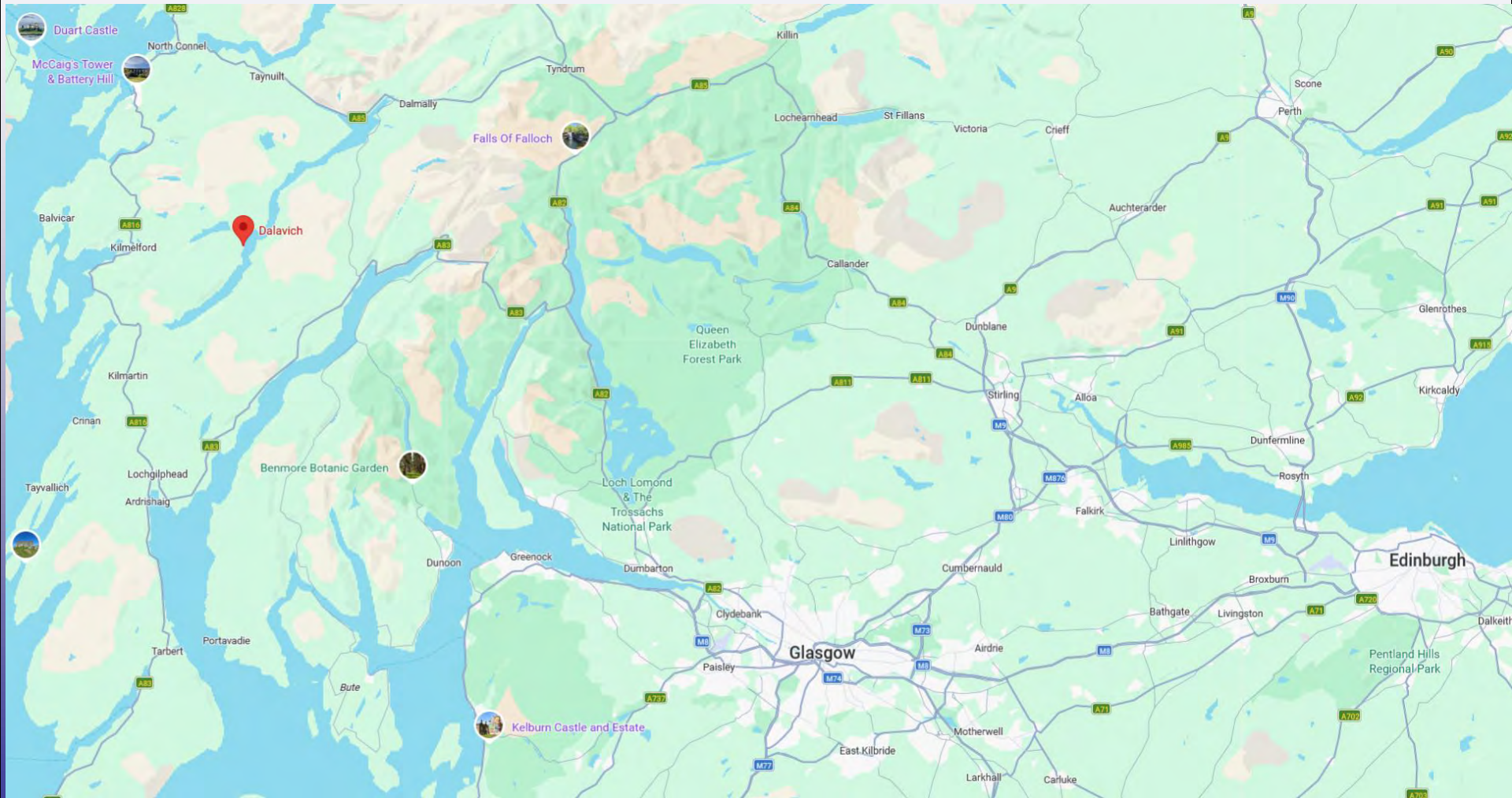

Loch Aweside Forest Cabins



Dear cabin guest,

Some useful information for your stay at Loch Awe Forest Cabins:

- Please remember to bring your towels. These are available for hire; please reserve in advance if required. All bed linen and tea towels are provided.
- A toilet roll will be left in each bathroom but please remember to bring extra with you.
- All electricity costs are included within rental sum.
- Logs for wood burner, hot tubs (if applicable) or outside fires are available from the village shop or via Georgia (House Keeper) on 07769 221911.
- There is a notice board at the north entrance to the site, which gives useful information about site and local activities.
- Village shop sells all basics and also has an excellent café. We do however recommend a super market shop on the way up for the majority of provisions for your stay.
- Boat hire is available from Loch Awe Marine at the village marina. It is prudent to book in advance. Contact Tam or Georgia McPherson at www.lochaweside-marine.co.uk , email: lochawesidemarine@gmail.com or tel on 07541 206698 or 07769 221911.
- You have our consent (as Riparian fishing right owners) to fish from the sites communal areas or anywhere on loch Awe from a boat without the need for a permit. For fishing in any other off site areas Fishing permits can be obtained from Tam McPherson at the marina (see above) or the village shop. Tam is also a useful source of fishing knowledge and can provide rod hire.
- Fishing rules are displayed on site and are on rear of permits. Please ensure you adhere to these rules and take your litter home with you.
- Loch View Bar & Restaurant is in the village at the south end of the site. Opening times vary according to time of year & are displayed on site notice board & on bar door. The bar is at the rear of the Community Centre, accessed through front or side door. **We cannot guarantee opening hours during low season.**
- Cot and high chair are available for hire. Please reserve in advance.
- There is a boat launch facility on site, free to cabin guests. Loch Awe is a famous fishing destination and has lots of islands, bays and castle ruins to explore.
- We have also sent you a map of the site to help you find your cabin and local amenities.
- All cabins have instruction booklets in to let you know how everything works. If you have a cabin with a wood burner or hot tub please be sure to follow instructions for use and empty ash to metal bucket provided.
- Tourist information is supplied in all cabins but for more information on local attractions please refer to the links section of our web site.
- There is a bin store at the north entrance to the site for all cabin waste (except ash). Please do not use site litter bins for cabin waste, these are for litter only.
- Please keep dogs on leads while on the communal areas of the site and pick up after them.
- All cabins are no smoking areas.
- All cabins have stone fire circles for outside fires. Please do not light fires other than in these circles and do not leave unattended.
- There is a coin operated laundry in the front of the community centre at south end of the site.

Most importantly have a lovely time.

On departure please turn off all electrics, return key to key safe and spin dials. Please feel free to make comments in guest book provided. We request that cabin is left, within reason, as you found it please.
